Requirements and Responsibilities:

- Board Certification (BCBA/BCaBA)
- Administer assessments including but not limited to VB MAPP, Essentials for Living, AFLS, ABLLS, and PDDBI
- Create and modify individualized treatment plans for each client on caseload
- Observe client during treatment, compile and evaluate data on client responses to treatments and progress
- Conduct functional assessments and analyses
- Create behavior plans for each child on caseload as needed, monitor implementation, and provide feedback as necessary
- Create and supervise implementation of new programs
- Train, supervise, provide feedback and coaching for all RBTs on principles of ABA and client's program under the direction of the Director of Clinical Services
- Attend and participate in parent team meetings, therapist meetings, trainings, professional development and other meetings as needed
